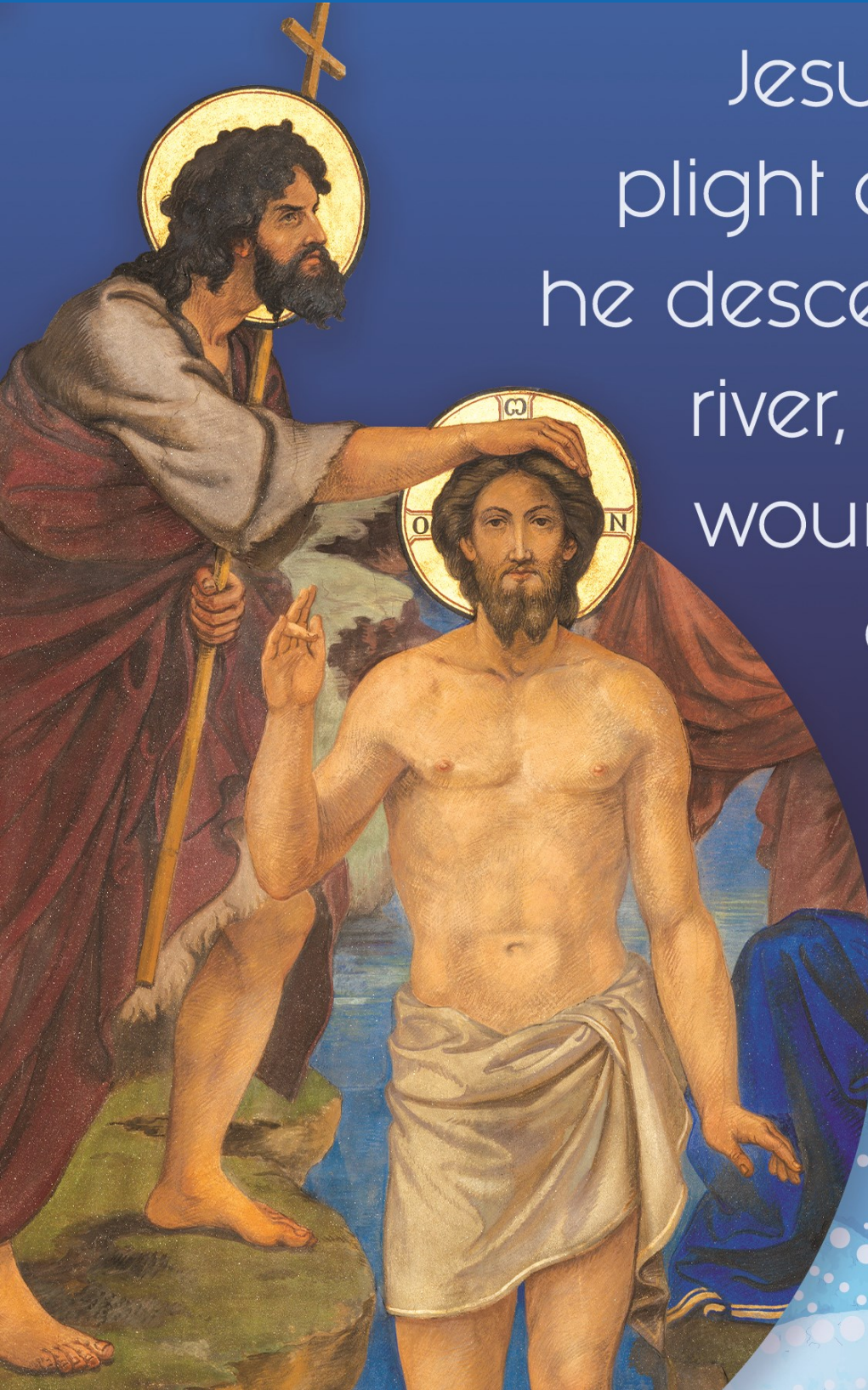
Weekday Mass
