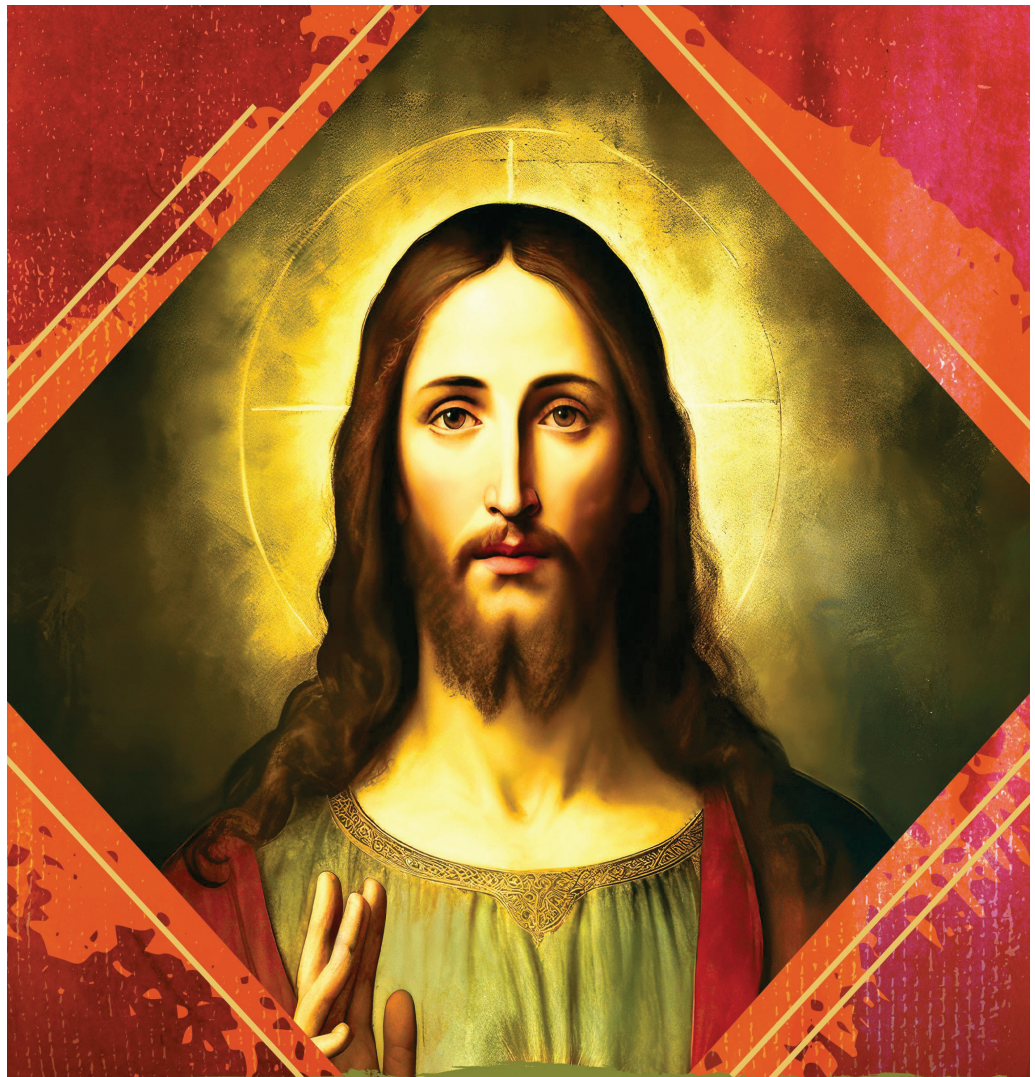


OLMCC Food Pantry Donations
