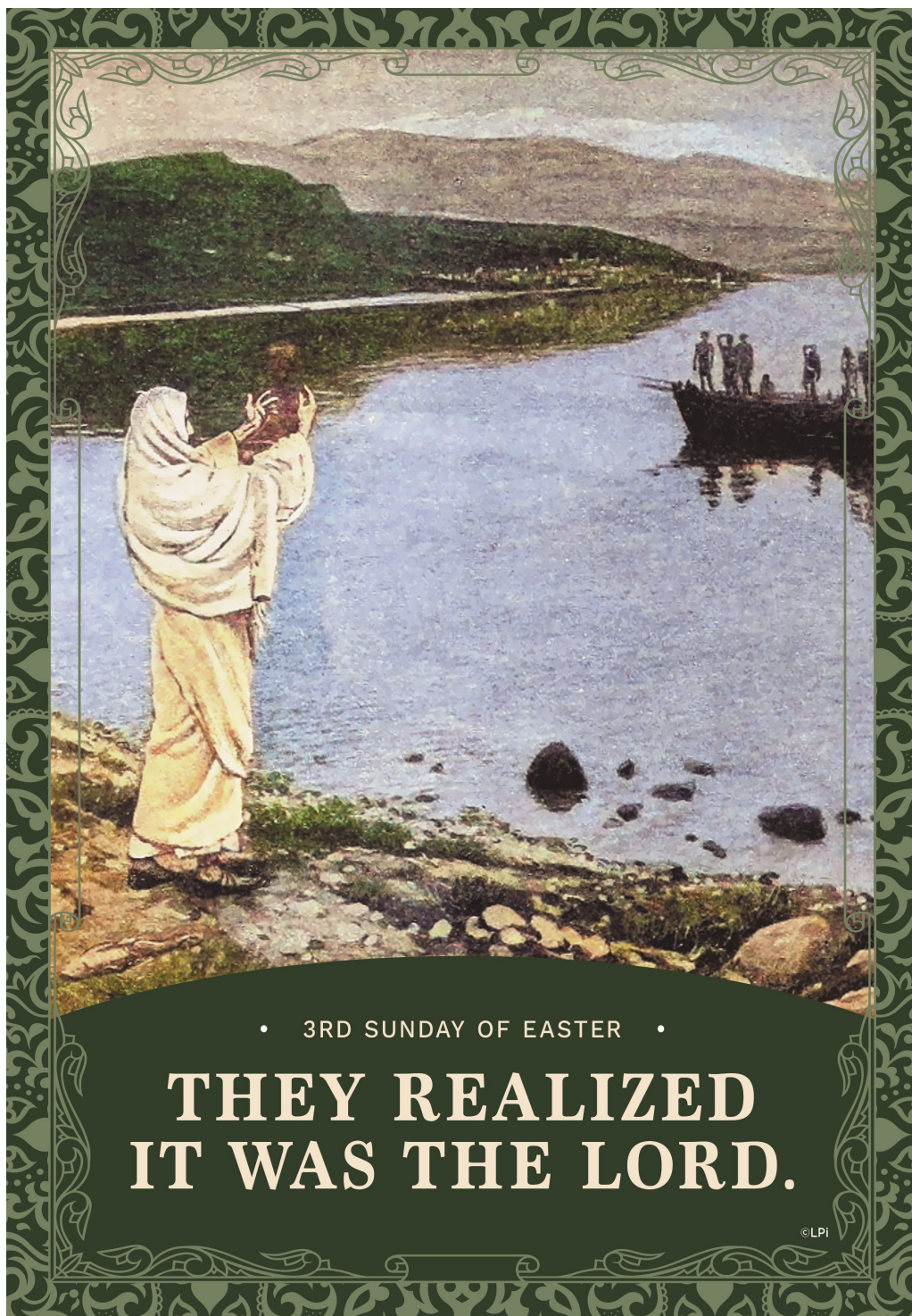

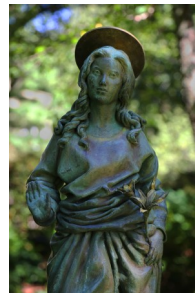
May Crowning
