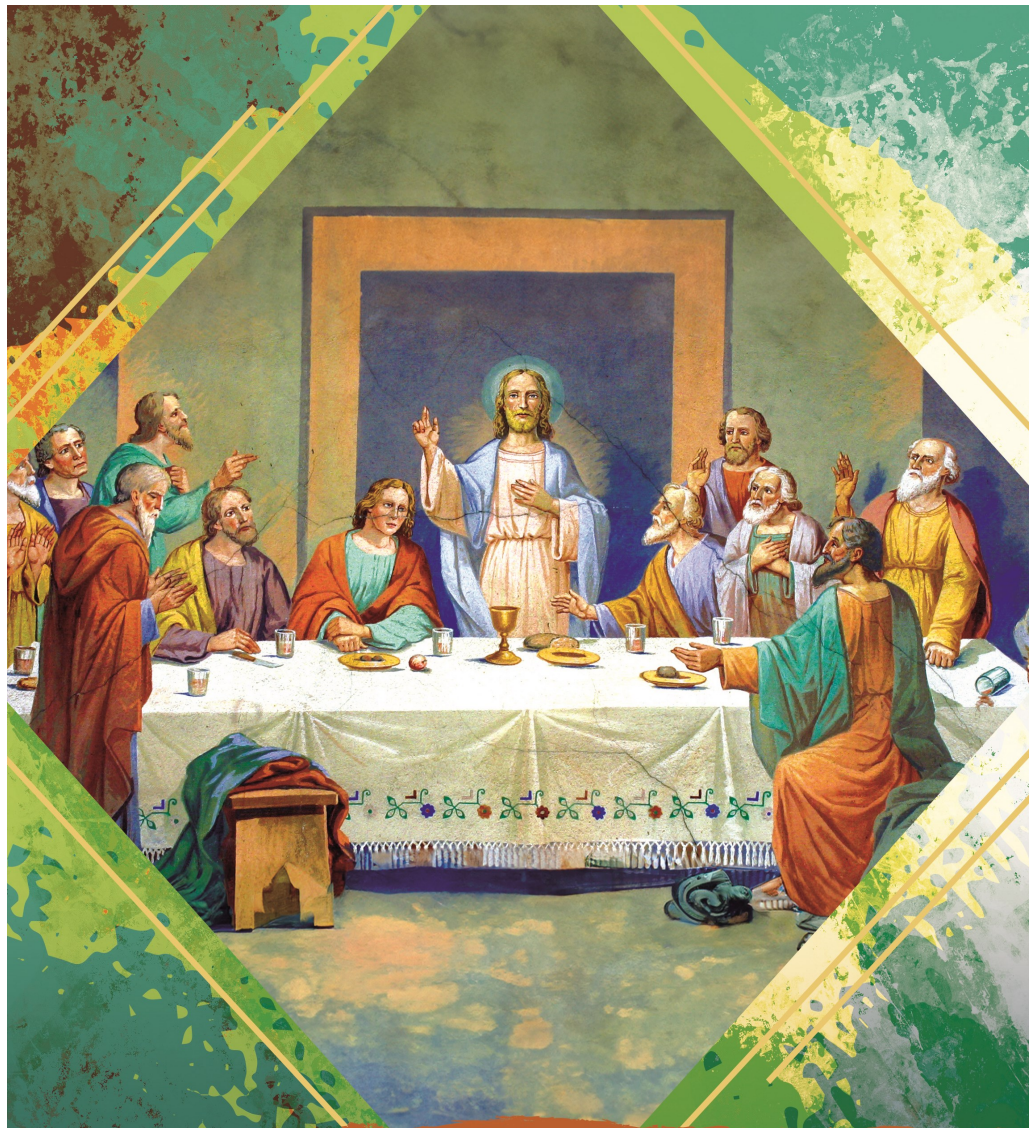

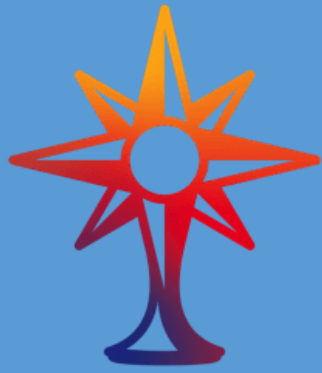
### Prison Ministry Outreach
