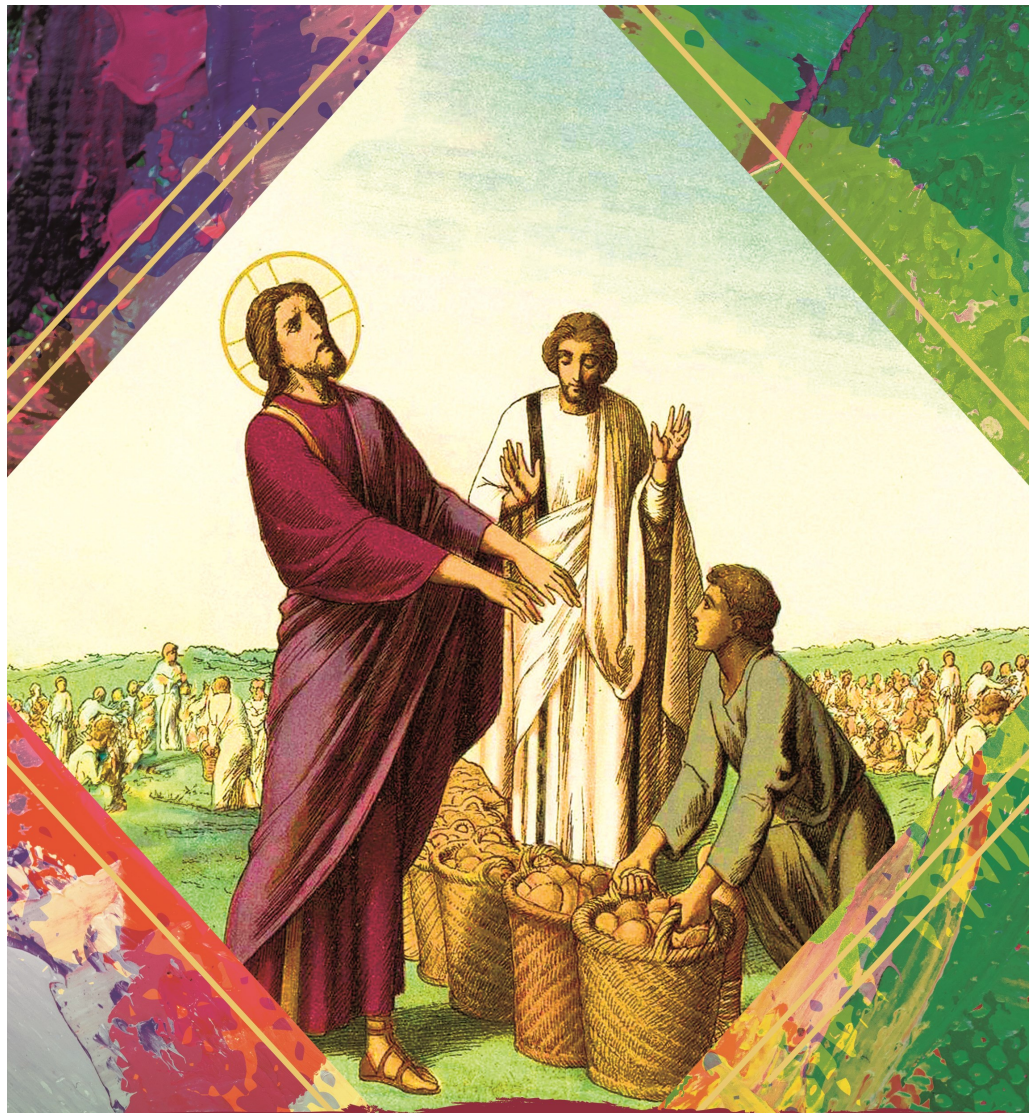

Parish Support Needed


Prayerfully consider volunteering for the following opportunities to serve our parish:
