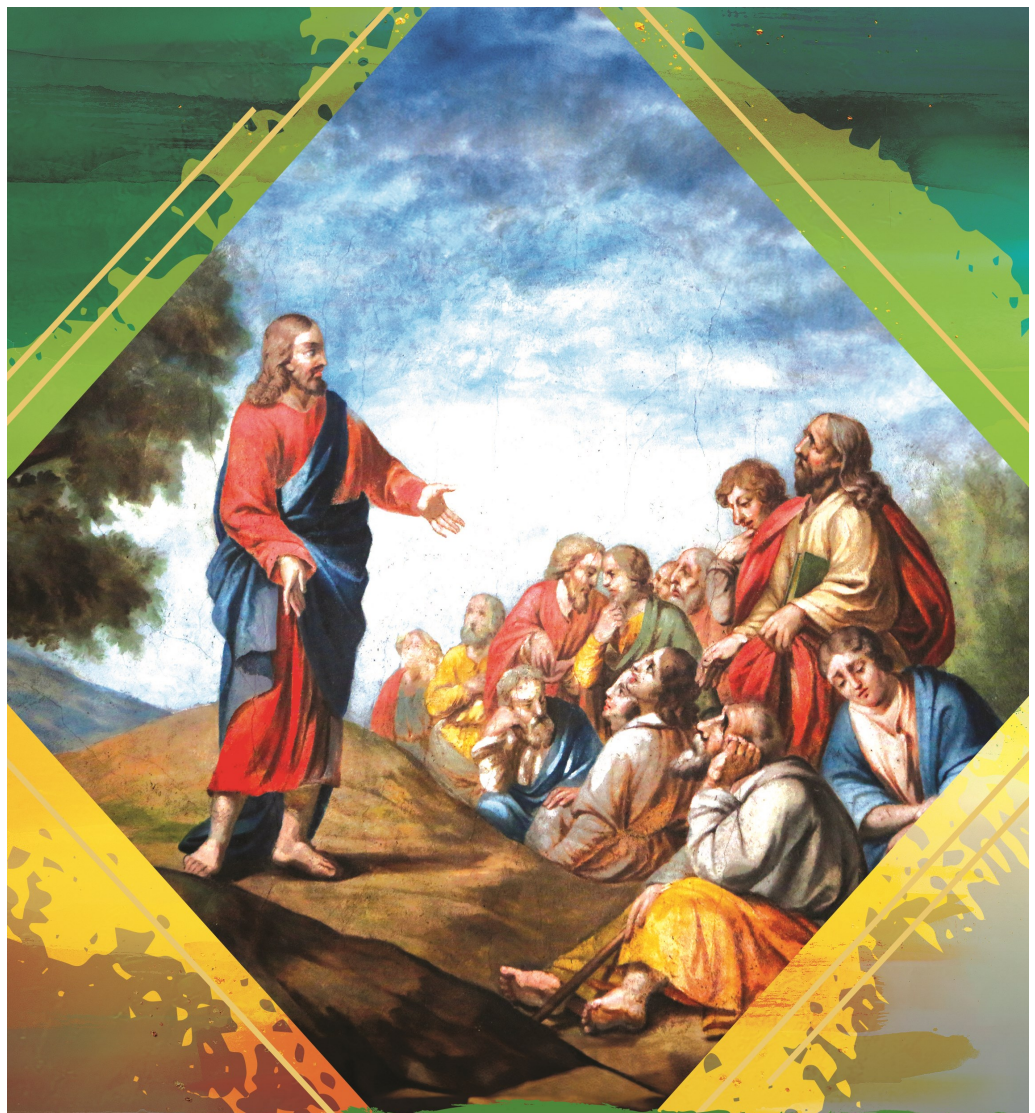

Holy Day of Obligation

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a Holy Day of Obligation for Catholics to attend Mass.

Safe Environment Training at OLMCC

There will be Safe Environment training on Saturday, August 10 from 10:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. in Shuler Hall. The training will be led by a facilitator provided by the Archdiocese of Atlanta.

Anyone who serves in any capacity at OLMCC or SKD must be Safe Environment certified. Once you receive this mandatory training, it is good for five years and then can be renewed online thereafter.

Those who need to attend this training include all of the following: current/future PRE volunteers, ushers, offertory counters, lectors, sacristans, greeters, housekeepers, and organists. Anyone who may want to be involved in any ministry in the present or future at OLMCC or SKD is strongly encouraged to attend this training.

Safe environment training is a requirement and the parish will be audited for compliance. Snacks and soft drinks will be provided during the training.

Parish Support Needed

Prayerfully consider volunteering for the following opportunities to serve our parish:

- Lectors (read at Mass)
- Sacristans (set up before/clean up after Mass)
- Altar servers (assist the priest during Mass)
- Catechists (teach the faith to our children on Sundays during the school year)
- Leader for the Women's Fall Bible study in the evening or possibly a weekday morning

None of the above positions require any experience. However, a 3-hour training course (for adults only) in Safe Environment protocols is a requirement of the archdiocese. Once that training is completed, it is good for five years.
