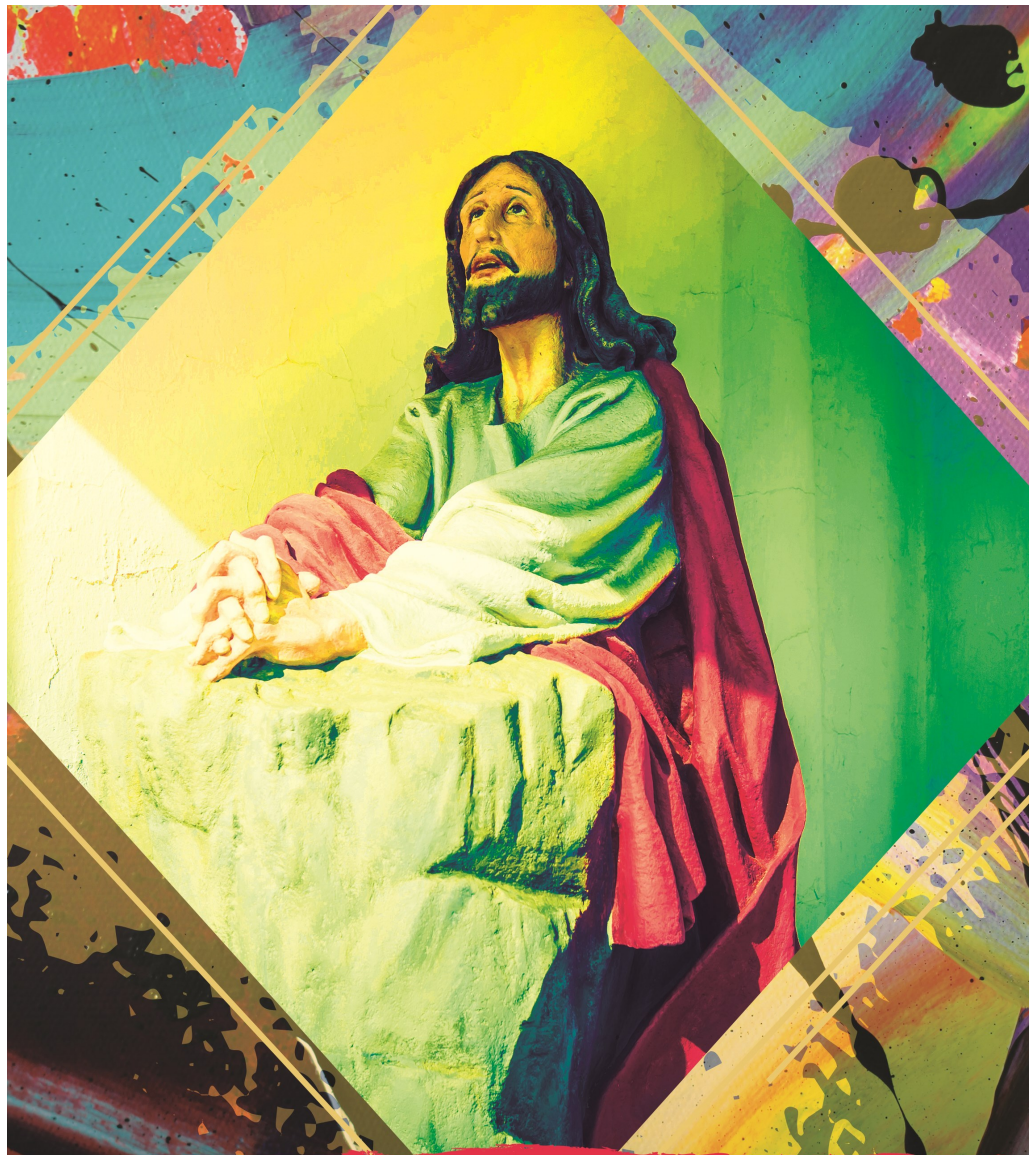

Parish Support Needed

Prayerfully consider volunteering for the following opportunities to serve our parish:

- Lectors (read at Mass)
- Sacristans (set up before/clean up after Mass)
- Altar servers (assist the priest during Mass)
- Catechists (teach the faith to our children on Sundays during the school year)
- Leader for the Women's Fall Bible study in the evening or possibly a weekday morning

None of the above positions require any experience. However, a 3-hour training course (for adults only) in Safe Environment protocols is a requirement of the archdiocese. Once that training is completed, it is good for five years.

Dear Parishioners of Our Lady of the Mount,

As Fall approaches and we prepare for another year of Parish Religious Education (PRE) starting September 8, it is an excellent time to remind everyone how to ensure the children stay safe on Sunday mornings. Please do not allow your children to go from the church to PRE in the downstairs classroom area unaccompanied. Walk them to their PRE teacher. If you drop a child off after Mass, please park your car and walk your child into the building to the teacher. We don't want children running across the parking lot after Mass ends. The same applies to pick-up time when PRE ends at 11:00 a.m. Park and enter the building to pick up your child. As always, anyone who wants Ms. Sheron and Ms. Sheila to watch their younger children and babies during Mass or during PRE should go with your child directly to the classrooms used by these ladies who do such a great service for our parish. I would also encourage all parents to walk to the restrooms with their younger children during Mass. It is important for all to realize that on any given Sunday, we have visitors at Mass whom we do not know. May God continue to bless our parish family as we move forward together as a Community through Communion.
