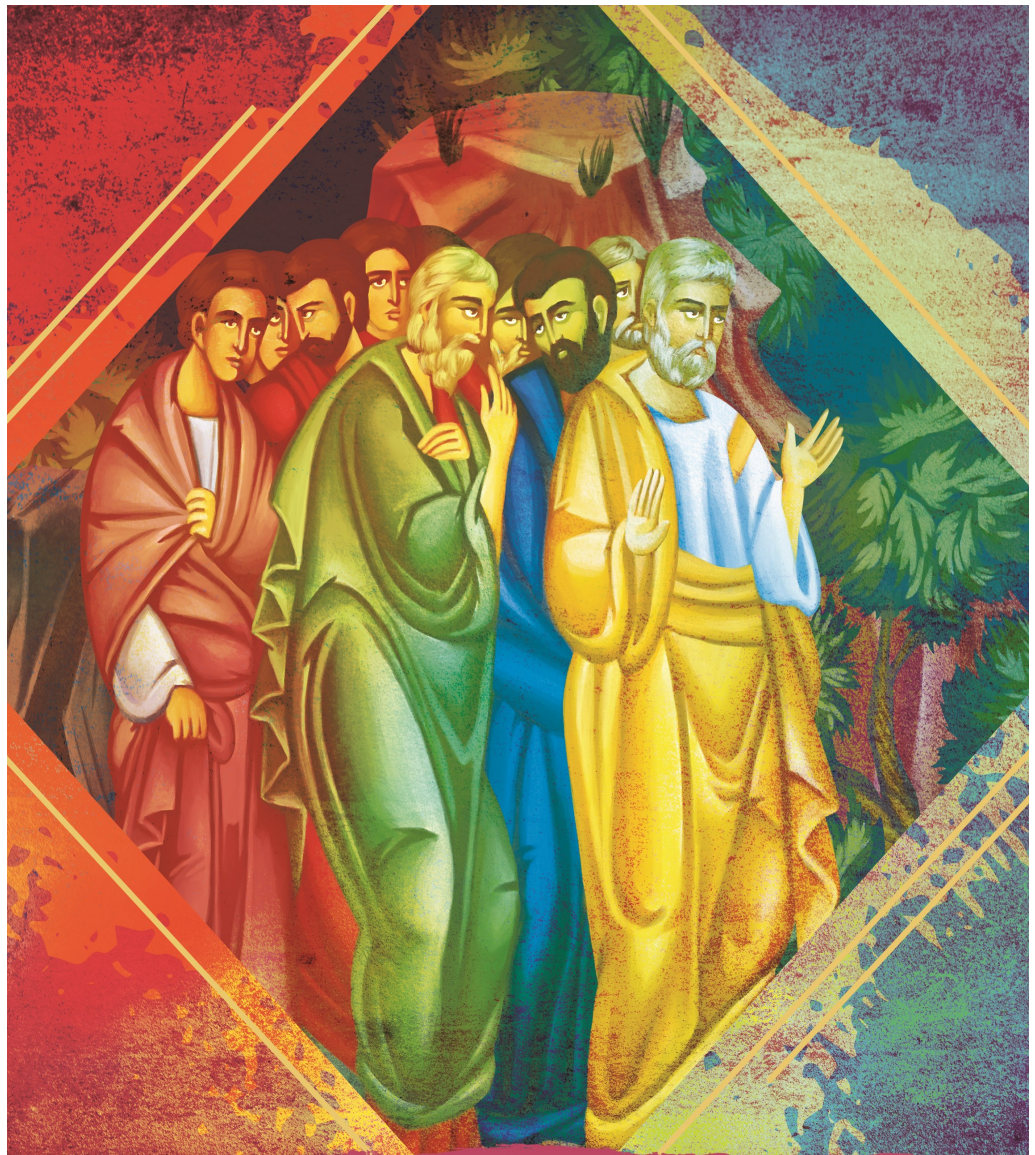

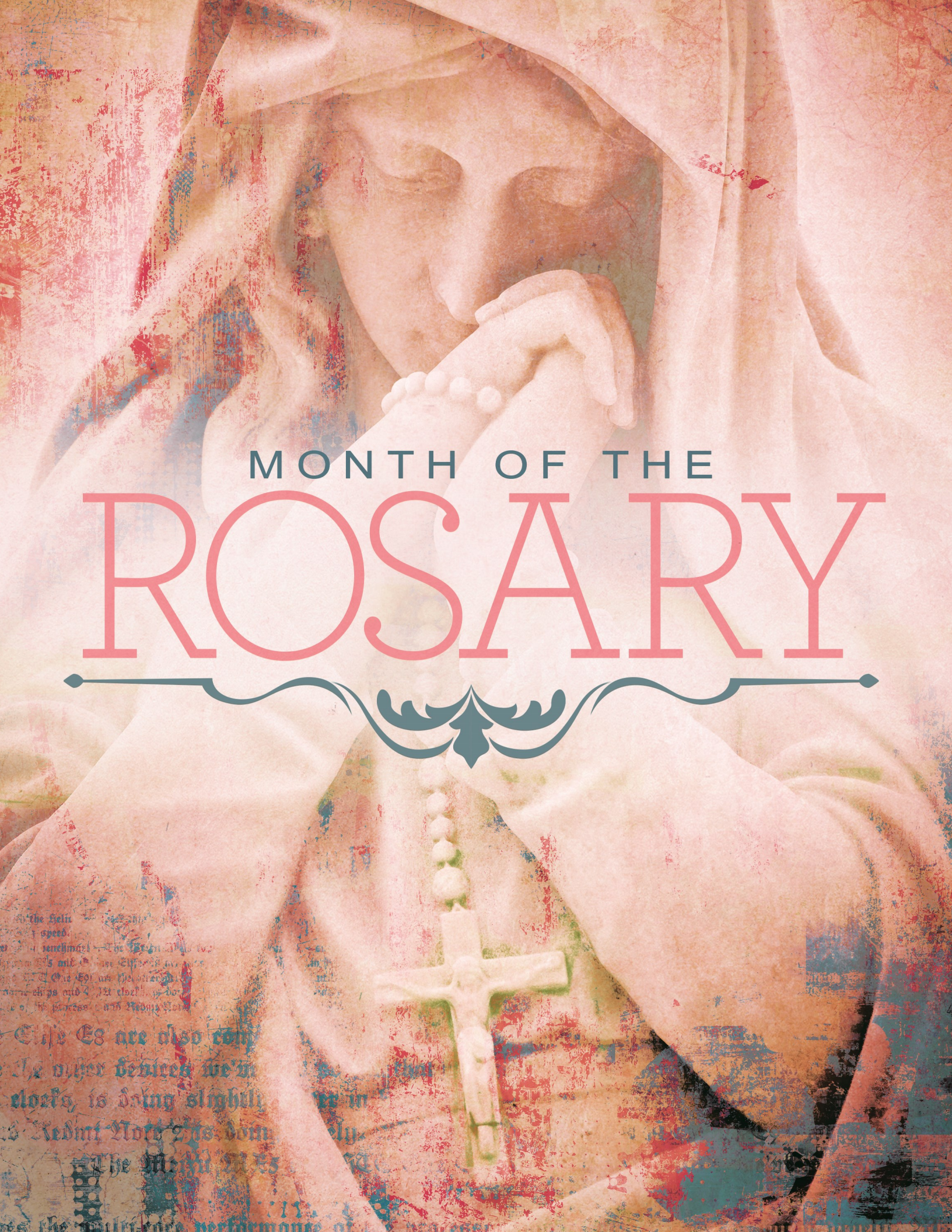


Oktoberfest 2022
