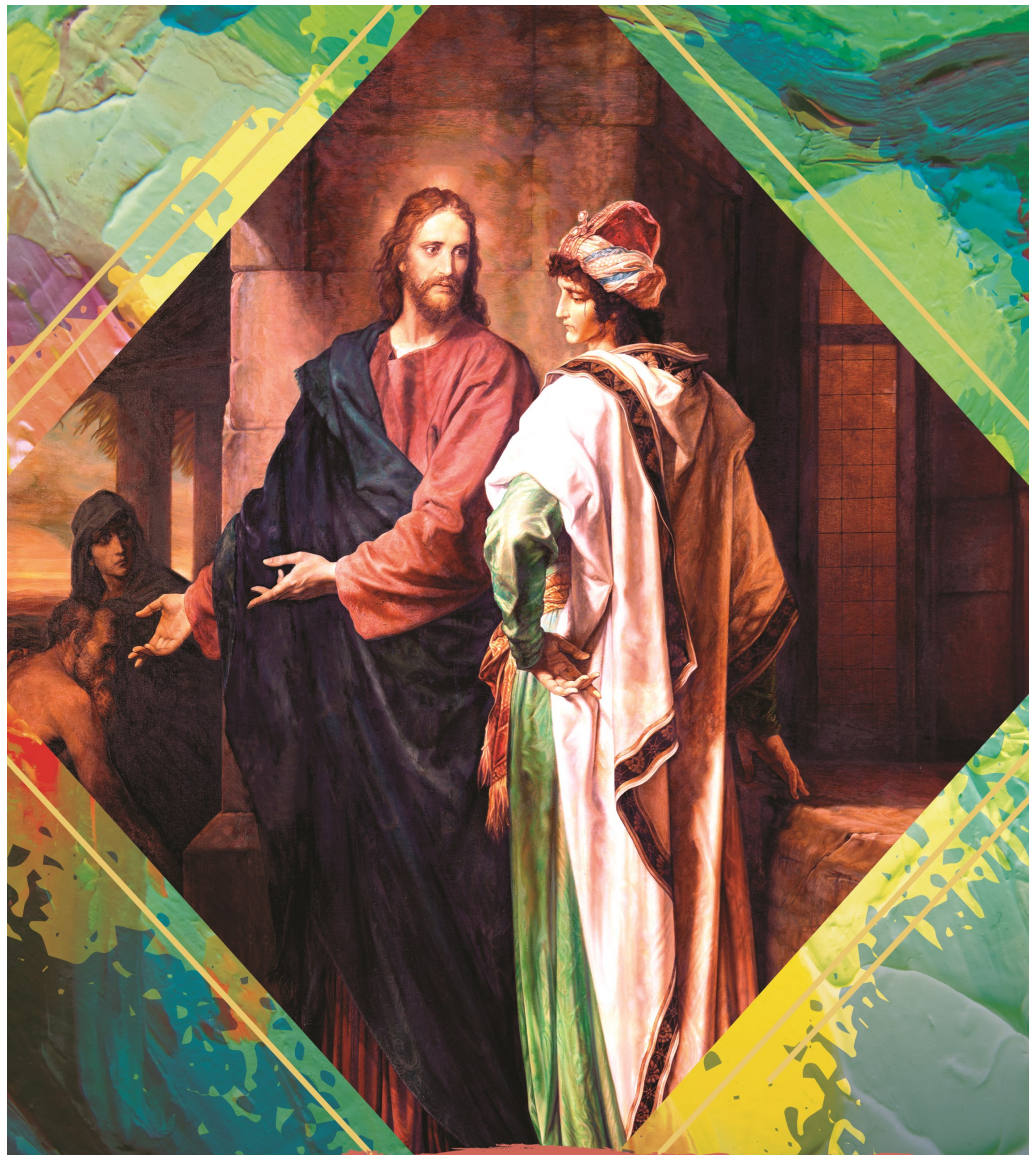

Parents must complete required forms for Parish Religious Education. Confirmandi (those to be Confirmed) must attend classes regularly on scheduled Sundays from 10:00-11:00 a.m. The next scheduled Sundays are: Oct. 20, 27; Nov. 3, 10, 17; Dec. 8, 15. Required Sundays in 2025 will be announced later.
