Solemnity of All Saints, November 1

All Saints Day, Friday, November 1, is a holy day of obligation. Masses will be celebrated at Our Lady of the Mount at 9:00 a.m., at St. Katharine Drexel at 5:00 p.m., and at Our Lady of the Mount at 7:00 p.m.

All Souls Day, November 2

All Souls Day Mass will be celebrated at Our Lady of the Mount at 9:00 a.m., followed by a blessing of the graves in the memorial garden. There will be no Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

Holiday Schedule Update - December 9

The 2024-2025 holiday schedule shared last weekend incorrectly indicated that the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception was not a Holy Day of Obligation this year. However, the archdiocese recently notified us that it is a Holy Day of Obligation. An additional Mass has been added for Monday, December 9. Immaculate Conception Masses will be offered at 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. (OLMCC) and 5:00 p.m. (SKD).

Confirmation

Middle and high school age parishioners are eligible to receive the sacrament of Confirmation at the 5:30 p.m. Vigil Mass on May 24, 2025. Parents must complete required forms for Parish Religious Education. Confirmandi (those to be Confirmed) must attend classes regularly on scheduled Sundays from 10:00-11:00 a.m. The next scheduled Sundays are: Oct. 20, 27; Nov. 3, 10, 17; Dec. 8, 15. Required Sundays in 2025 will be announced later.
