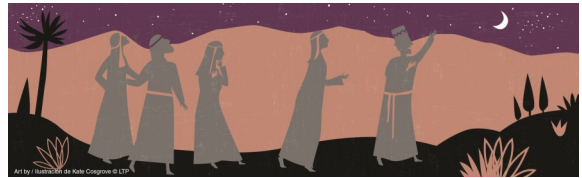
Poinsettia Remembrances
