

# O.C.I.A. is Coming in January 2025 (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults)

Would you or someone you know like to learn more about the Catholic faith?

-Perhaps your spouse or fiancé is thinking about becoming a Catholic?

-Maybe you were raised Catholic, but never received the sacrament of Confirmation?

-Maybe you have never been baptized by any Christian church or maybe you have never belonged to a faith community?

-Maybe you've drifted away from the Church and want to renew your connection to Catholicism by refreshing your knowledge of the Church's teaching?

-There is never any commitment to become Catholic. That is a personal decision to be made by each individual participant.

- Participants who decide to become Catholic will be brought into full communion with the Church (Confirmation) at the Easter Vigil, Saturday night, April 19, 2025.
